# Third Call for Applications

The Third Call for Applications runs from the **15th of August** to the **26<sup>th</sup> of September 2008**. The call is open to applicants from across the programme area and to projects addressing both priorities:

- 1. Promoting innovation and competitiveness in remote and peripheral areas
- 2. Sustainable development of natural and community resources

#### **Themes**

At its last meeting, the Programme Monitoring Committee (PMC) made an analysis of the themes addressed by the 17 approved main projects so far. The PMC identified a number of themes that are not yet addressed by the programme.

Although, the Third Call for Applications is an open call, **the PMC especially welcomes projects addressing these themes**:

- In **Priority 1**, in the Objective "To facilitate development through the use of advanced information and communication technologies and transportation in the programme area" and the four themes:
  - i) increased use of ICT to overcome distance
  - developing innovative product and service solutions for developing and maintaining transport infrastructure with regard to roads, railways, airports and ports under harsh climatic conditions
  - iv) development of transport schemes that benefit rural communities, such as new maritime routes
  - v) maritime safety in relation to remote areas with arctic, harsh conditions.
- In **Priority 2**, in the Objective "To strengthen the synergies between environmental protection and growth in remote and peripheral regions and the two themes:
  - ii) Impact and possible implications of climate change and means to reduce it at a community level
  - iii) Development of small scale renewable energy solutions
- In **Priority 2**, in the Objective "To improve sustainable development in peripheral regions by strengthening urban-rural relations and enhancing regional heritage" and the two themes:
  - i) urban-rural partnerships for new service solutions and
  - iv) promotion of natural and cultural heritage that supports the development of sustainable industries



## **Available Funding**

No specific budget allocation has been set for this Third Call. Between 2007 and 2013 the Programme will commit around €45 million to projects that address the priorities for transnational cooperation: €35.115 million of European funds (ERDF) will be available to partners in Member States and €10.155 for partners in the Non member States. 60% of the funds is available for projects applying under Priority 1 and 40% for projects under Priority 2. After the first two calls, in which 17 projects were approved, 41.6% of the programme funds has been allocated.

The recommended minimum size for a main project's total budget is €250 000 and the recommended maximum size is €1.5 million. In general, a 60% grant rate is applied for partners in Member States and 50% for Non Member States. For Norwegian partners, a grant rate of 30% applies.

- Application Form: Parts 1-2 in Word format and Part 3 in Excel format
- Application Instructions
- Programme Manual: Part 1 How to Apply and Part 4 Common Eligibility Rules

#### **Decisions**

Decisions on all main project applications submitted to the Third Call for proposals will be made at the Programme Monitoring Committee meeting on 3<sup>rd</sup>-4<sup>th</sup> December 2008.
